

## OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY LEGAL REQUIREMENTS APPLICABLE TO 18001:2007

### OVERVIEW

For personnel to implement, manage and evaluate an Occupational Health and Safety Management System effectively, they require an understanding of legal issues pertaining to an OHSMS. The employer has both a legal and moral duty to ensure that employees, the community and third parties are safeguarded as far as is reasonably practicable against occupational hazards and risk. The appropriate knowledge and understanding of legislation is essential for employees and management both from a common sense and a legal approach.

Note: The course focuses on obligations imposed by the respective Acts and Regulations of which personnel must have an understanding and not on philosophies underpinning the legislation.
